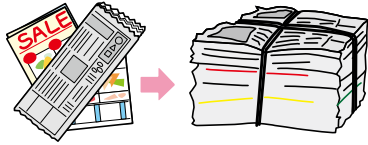


# Used Paper Separate into 4 Types

## Newspapers • Flyers

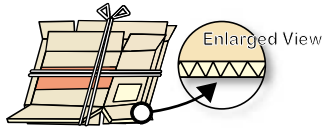


Please put newspapers and flyers in one pile as shown above

## Cardboard

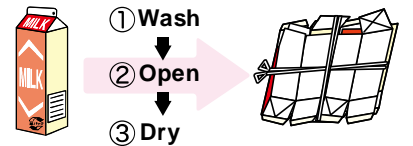
Attention mark

The below illustration has examples of miscellaneous papers.

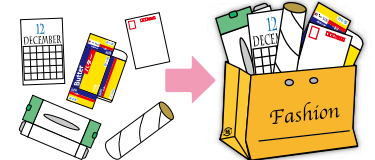


## A Point About Disposal

Please remove any plastic.



For small things that are hard to tie together, you can use paper bags or envelopes.



- Please do not throw out paper on rainy days. If you do, it will get moldy and we can't recycle it.
- Please don't put paper in plastic trash bags or cardboard, or use sticky tape to tie things together. Please tie with string as shown above.
- Please remove items with private information, tear up paper cartons into small pieces, and be careful not to mix them with "burnable trash".

Things that don't fall under this category. ( Example )

Even though the following items are paper, they fall under "Burnable Trash", so be careful! ( See page 8 )



Some items with the mark don't fall under this category!

- Dirty Paper (Pizza Boxes, etc.)
- Wet Paper
- Strong Smelling Paper (Detergent Boxes, etc.)
- Waterproof Paper (Paper Plates, Paper Cups, etc.)
- Thermal paper (Receipts, etc.)
- Carbon Paper (Delivery Vouchers, etc.)
- Peeling paper (Seals, crimped postcard, etc.)
- Paper with several materials (For example, paper that contains aluminum or plastic)
- Oily paper ● Photographs
